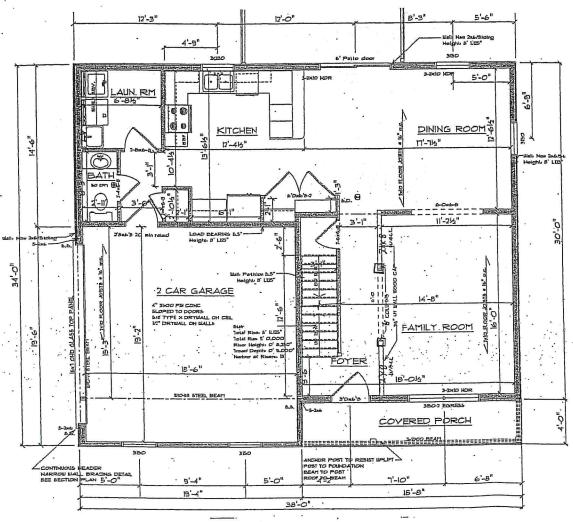

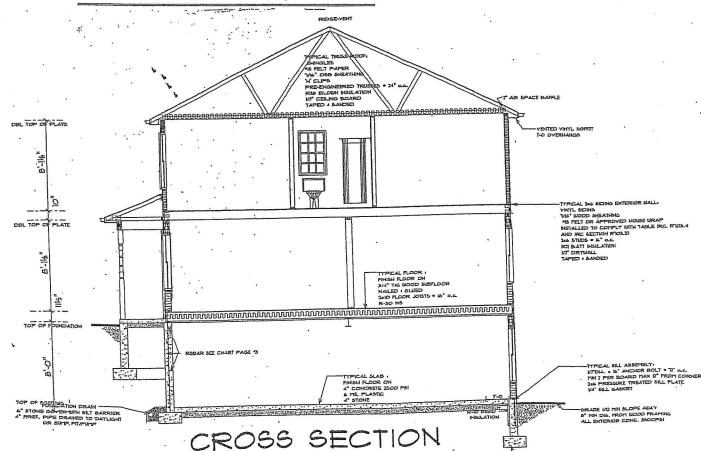

Waters of this Commonwealth – rivers, streams, creeks, rivulets, impoundments, ditches, watercourses, storm sewers, lakes, dammed water, wetlands, ponds, springs and other bodies or channels of conveyance of surface and underground water, or parts thereof, whether natural or artificial, within or on the boundaries of this Commonwealth
**** For earth disturbance activities of less than 5000 sq ft, erosion and sediment control best management practices shall still be incorporated into the project.
